eManifest Implementation

Please see below release from CBSA and associated link.

While CBSA will not be issuing penalties/denial of entry into Canada during the compliance period, it is essential that you are set up as soon as possible.

****EFFECTIVE MAY 2013 THERE WILL BE ZERO TOLERANCE FOR NON-COMPLIANT CARRIERS****

Scout has developed an in-house data management system whereby we are able to act as a bridge to ensure that documentation is properly submitted within the required time frame of border arrival. Alternatively, Scout can offer carriers assistance in transmitting the data for themselves.

An informed compliance period for highway carriers will begin November 1, 2012, and remain in effect until May 2013 when eManifest-enabling legislation and regulations are expected to be in place.

During this six-month informed compliance period, carriers will not be denied entry to Canada or subject to penalties for reasons associated with eManifest non-compliance.

The CBSA will continue to assist clients in becoming eManifest-compliant through communications, outreach, compliance monitoring and other support activities.

In May 2013, eManifest highway carrier requirements are expected to be mandatory and non-compliant carriers could be subject to penalties.
