



INTRODUCING THE FIRST ANNUAL "SCOUT SHOOTOUT SHOWDOWN"

This week marks the inaugural debut of the Scout Logistics "Shootout Showdown" – the fast pitch event of the summer!! With multiple venues across the GTA, close to 100 participants will bring together the ideals of camaraderie, competition and charity to make this event one to remember!

Over the three days, teams will compete in a round-robin style tournament to claim their share of monies raised for their nominated charity: The [Durham Bulls](#) will be playing for the [ALS Society](#), the [Toronto Gators](#) will be playing for [Hockey Helps the Homeless](#), [Scout Logistics](#) will be playing for the [Bridle Bash Foundation](#) and [Maccabi Canada](#) will play for the [Ontario Mental Health Association](#).

The first place champions will receive 40% of the purse, the finalists 30%, consolation winners 20%, and consolation finalists 10% to donate to their chosen charity.

When planning for the event began, Scout Logistics pledged a minimum purse of \$15,000, now as we head into the final days before the tournament begins the total purse sits at just under \$30,000!

Thursday's games will take place at the picturesque [Bayview and Yorkmills park](#), while Friday and Saturdays games will move to historic [Hendon Park](#). The tournament aims to bring together teammates, friends, and families to participate in a fun, competitive tournament to renew old relationships, re-live old memories, make new ones with all proceeds being donated to the [four registered Canadian charities](#) selected by the teams.

Once the festivities of the tournament have been completed, winners have been announced and monies have been distributed, Scout Logistics will be hosting an after-party for all the players and volunteers who have been involved in the planning of the event.
